Judenhetzer Nummer eins vor Gericht: Julius Streicher in Nürnberg ("Jew-Baiter Number One on Trail: Julius Streicher at Nuremberg")

**Abstract**

Julius Streicher was a glutton of the media. He frequently spread anti-Semitism through his newspaper Der Stürmer. For 23 years, Streicher published his newspaper from his office in Nuremberg, where he presented libelous articles about Jews to the German people. Der Stürmer regularly featured racist caricatures of Jews, Communists, and other "enemies" of the Nazi state. Every issue featured the slogan that translates to "The Jews are our misfortune." For his fervent incitement of the German people into an anti-Semitic frenzy, Julius Streicher was one of 21 defendants present for the Trial of the Major War Criminals at Nuremberg (24 were indicted, but one was tried in absentia, one committed suicide in prison, and another was acquitted on medical grounds).
